

TCN OVERVIEW: NOVEMBER 2012

The **TCN team** continues to focus its energies on serving, motivating and mobilizing Christian leaders in NM Bay.

The highlight of the year has been the **actions** that have begun to flow out of the **unity** between Church leaders. A group of 25 leaders from all the denominations continue to meet monthly for a time of prayer, fellowship and consultation. At a recent meeting the group initiated the appointment, by their peers, of 12 City **Church elders**. (Bishop Bethlehem Nopece, Bishop Lunga KA Siboto, ...+ 10 others Denise).

The most significant milestone reached this year was the acceptance of the **Nehemiah Vision**. This vision will serve as a framework to take the city to the next level of unity. It will also position the Church as a key role player in the transformation of NM Bay. The vision will be shared with the city at a Prayer Meeting in the Feathermarket Hall on Sunday, 9 December 2012.

A dedicated group of voluntary coordinators continue to work together for TCN. I believe that the work done by this team during 2012 has put them in an excellent position to start reaping the benefits of their labour in 2013. We have made two important decisions that should enhance our current team. Firstly, the appointment of "**part time consultants**" to assist us in areas where we feel we are a little thin. Two of these areas are media & communication and local government prayer networks. Secondly, the appointment of a group of "**younger church leaders**" as advisors to the current coordinators about the way forward for the 18 to 35 year old group. We have approached Pastor Afrika Mhlophe to recommend a group of suitable persons.
